### Partnership strategy, development and mapping

- Build relationship and increase capacity with existing MA-UK partners
- In close collaboration with area and program staff, identify strategic partners, as needed.
- Support area offices in mapping potential partners and identifying strategic ones.
- Develop a partnership strategy and framework for MA-UK in Myanmar, reflective of the context, the Strategic Programme Document, and program priorities in relevant areas.
- Work closely with leadership teams to develop remote management modalities, particularly around partnerships, and reflective of responsible partnership principles.
- Contribute to innovative programming by providing partnership solutions to operational challenges
- Close working with Head of Programmes and Operations to build good relationships with all partners and stakeholders.
- Improve, implement and apply theory of change and work plan of MA-UK Myanmar 2021 with partners.
- Work with programs and area-management teams to identify potential pilots for partnership programming
- Lead a national and area-level reflections on partnership and exit strategies
- Lead on partner engagement as part of the proposal design process, in line with relevant technical coordinators and program managers
- Lead the start-up of pilot partnership programs in a management capacity ensuring that partnership principles and processes are followed
- Resource mobilisation – contribute/support team for identification of new donors, financial partners and new funding opportunities through the MA-UK partnership approach.
- Provide input and writing for new program design, as needed.

- Build, maintain and manage long term relationships with partner organisation
- Provide day-to day management coach and mentor to partners.
- Ensure partners increased capacity (skill and knowledge) and take ownership to implement the project.
